Separate sealed bids for **Contract 124 – Pomona and Pleasant Hill Water Tank Repainting** will be received by **WEST CUMBERLAND UTILITY DISTRICT** at **321 East Main Street, Pleasant Hill, TN 38578**, until **2:00 P.M., local time, on April 8, 2025**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Any person with a disability requiring special accommodation must contact the **WEST CUMBERLAND UTILITY DISTRICT** no later than 7 days prior to the bid opening.

CONTRACT 124 consists of the rehabilitation of (1) 500,000-gallon (Pomona) elevated water storage tank and one (1) 150,000-gallon (Pleasant Hill) elevated water storage tank, piping, excavation, grading, and all and related appurtenances shown on plans.
