Separate sealed bids for **Contract 224 – Sewer System Rehabilitation** will be received by **CITY OF ALGOOD** at **215 West Main Street, Algood, TN 38506**, until **2:00 P.M., local time, on May 22, 2025**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Any person with a disability requiring special accommodation must contact the **CITY OF ALGOOD** no later than 7 days prior to the bid opening.

CONTRACT 224 consists of furnish & install by pipe burst approximately 3,300 linear feet of 8" PVC and clay and PVC pipe, including approximately 15 manhole replacements, 40 service reconnections and related appurtenances as shown on the plans and specifications. This project is being supported with Treasury, Coronavirus State and Local Recovery Fund grant funding. Therefore, certain restrictions and other federal requirements attach to this opportunity.

The allotted time for construction is 180 calendar days.
